Project Questions and Answers:

This document provides answers to questions asked by bidders who have reviewed the Technology Request for Bid for the above referenced project.

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| Q1 | Can you confirm the count of buses requiring WiFi? |
| A1 | 37 |
| Q2 | Can you confirm you would like proposals for both hardware and cellular data? |
| A2 | Correct. |
| Q3 | Is an installation quote needed for the proposed solution or do you have a need for a solution that is not permanently installed on the buses? |
| A3 | Installation should be included as specified. |
| Q4 | What is your cellular provider of choice between Verizon, T-Mobile, ATT, or US Cellular? We usually recommend a Kajeet solution for data that meets the necessary CIPA compliance. Alternatively, if you choose to work directly with a carrier, we will suggest using an Advanced SKU from Cradlepoint to ensure CIPA compliance. |
| A4 | As described in the bid document, any major carrier is acceptable. Please propose whatever solution meets the requirements of the bid document. Alternative solutions may be provided as a voluntary alternate bid. |
| Q5 | How many students do you anticipate connecting to wireless per bus? |
| A5 | No specific quantity of students has been identified at this time. |
| Q6 | LED Display – The Samsung QB series displays are not LED, they are LCD. Confirm the requirement of LED. |
| A6 | The Samsung QB75C 4K UHD digital signage monitors specified are LED. |

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| Q7 | Rooms with CD/Bluetooth players – is the expectation control to be provided on the touch panels for these players, or manual controls only? |
| A7 | Contractor shall provide touch screen control for volume control of this audio input only where applicable. |
| Q8 | Configuration H – Esport - Line drawings indicate there is an interactive monitor, but no mention of it in the scope / bill of materials. |
| A8 | See addendum 1. |
| Q9 | Configuration J & K - Hamilton Elementary Gym and Cafeteria - Each scope says: <i>One (1) Remote input location(s) shall be provided and installed (one in gymnasium one in cafeteria). Remote input location shall provide XLR and 3.5mm connectivity in identified locations.</i> Are these 2 systems supposed to connect or will each space have it's own and separate XLR/3.5 Wall plate? |
| A9 | Each space will have its own XLR/3.5 mm wall plate. |
| Q10 | Configuration K – Hamilton Elementary Cafeteria - Drawings indicate rack to be in the IDF, rack provided by others. Scope and bill of material list AV to provide a 12U rack. Which is correct? |
| A10 | See addendum 1. |
| Q11 | Configuration M – Valleywood Middle School Auditorium <i>Scope indicates (2) Voice amplification systems – handheld and lavalier microphone combo.</i> Is the request for (2) of each microphone type, but only (2) channels of audio (only 2 can be used at any given time)? Or one of each microphone type? |
| A11 | Contractor shall supply two (2) of each microphone type with two (2) channels of audio. |
| Q12 | Configuration M – Valleywood Middle School Auditorium Scope calls out (4) XLR input locations, drawings only indicates (2). Is it (2) XLR connections at (2) locations? Or (1) XLR connections at (2) locations? |
| A12 | Correct, two (2) XLR connections at two (2) locations. |
