Project Questions and Answers:

This document provides answers to questions asked by bidders who have reviewed the Technology Request for Bid for the above referenced project.

Q1	Asset tags – will these be provided by the awarded contractor, or by Rockford public schools for the TV’s and Signage players? Any specification on those tags? Heavy metal, etc?
A1	Rockford will supply the tags for the contractor to install.
Q2	Samsung QBB series 55” – Samsung has a few of the commercial sets –(QB55C latest model) but it appears the QB55R is the most suitable for the project – can you confirm an actual model number?
A2	QB55R
Q3	The spec calls for the AppleTV/Signage combo as the main, with Brightsign as the voluntary alternate, as well as the VSX for a secondary – Can you confirm?
A3	Specification calls for an onboard signage player as the main. Apple TV, VSX and BrightSign or approved equals are Mandatory Alternates.
Q4	JAMF onboarding of the proposed apple tv devices – without delegated access this will be tricky – I’m assuming we’d be working with Stephen at Rockford and his colleagues to facilitate that portion?
A4	Yes, the contractor will work with the Owner’s IT staff for JAMF onboarding of Apple devices.
Q5	Brightsign voluntary alternate – the Apple TV’s have built in wireless – should we be including the wireless module with the brightsign player?
A5	No, do not include the wireless module in the brightsign player. Owner preference is wired.

Q6	Ethernet drops – will they be placing (2) drops behind every TV for ethernet for the signage player and TV – or just one?
A6	Owner will be providing two data data drops behind every TV.
